



All of our treatment plans are developed under the supervision of a physician, while skilled nursing care provides continuous monitoring and patient/family education. Other specialists may also be a part of your care team when it is deemed necessary. Care teams and treatment plans may involve any of the following:

Physical Therapy

Physical therapists are available to help rehabilitate injuries, build strength, prevent falls, and assist in your recovery. Their focus is on helping you resume life activities, particularly walking, exercising, maintaining balance, and building strength and flexibility.

Occupational Therapy

Throughout your stay, occupational therapists will work with you to restore daily living skills and increase patient independence, including bathing, dressing and grooming, cooking, and basic housekeeping.

Speech Therapy

A speech therapist assists with recovering your communication skills, including expressing thoughts, reading, and safe swallowing.

Nutrition Services

Optimal nutrition is important in recovery and continued health. We offer nutritional support, education, and customized diets/menus to meet your personal preference and dietary needs.

Diabetes Education

A Certified Diabetes Educator is available for patients with a new diagnosis or those who have questions or concerns regarding their chronic diabetes.

Pharmacy

We have an on-staff pharmacist who can fill your prescriptions and work with your physician to assure your medication needs are met.

Recreational Activities

Our creative staff will develop an activity plan based on your interests and hobbies to meet your social interaction needs. Structured group activities as well as individual sessions aid in filling leisure time between therapy sessions.

Pulmonology/Respiratory Therapy

A pulmonologist is on staff and available to address any issues you may have during your stay with us. Our on-staff respiratory therapist can provide education about oxygen and other respiratory needs.

RN Case Manager/Social Work

Our social worker will work directly with you and your family to connect you to the services and resources you need, both during your stay with us and upon your return home.

Daily therapy is centered on self-care and body strengthening, which will increase your independence and help prepare you for returning home. Our expert care team will create an individualized, multi-disciplinary treatment plan that outlines therapeutic recovery goals focused on restoring you to your normal level of activity.

As a Swing Bed patient, you may remain in the program for as long as you have goals to obtain. Once your goals are met, you will be discharged from the program.

Our Swing Bed Program at Columbus Community Hospital provides an extended care opportunity for individuals who are continuing to recover, but no longer need an acute hospital setting. Specifically, it's for patients who no longer need the acute level of care following an illness, stroke, injury or surgery. Yet, they're not quite physically able to return home and need a few more days to heal and regain their strength.

Qualified patients who have been admitted to Columbus Community Hospital for acute care can transfer to our Swing Bed Program for the rehabilitation phase of recovery without ever leaving the hospital.

Even patients who are in another acute care facility elsewhere can transfer to our Swing Bed Program here in Columbus. This allows you to be close to home, family and friends during your recovery.

Independence is the center of our attention.

Every effort is focused on independence, and as a Swing Bed patient, you'll be encouraged to do as much as you can for yourself. You will be expected to wear your own clothes, and take part in a variety of daily activities in order to enhance and achieve greater independence. In the spirit of camaraderie, our Swing Bed patients also take their meals together.
